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JUDGMENT

This matter came before this Honorable Court on a Hearing on the State's Motion for Summery Judgment, Plaintiff's Motion to Compel & Plaintiff's Motion in Limine heard on September 21, 2017.

Present were: Thomas E. Townsley, Attorney at Law, on behalf of the plaintiff, EMILY LANDERS; and Cearley Fontenot, Counsel for the STATE OF LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY & CORRECTIONS, LOUISIANA STATE POLICE.

IT IS ORDERED that the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Motion to Compel, filed by plaintiff, is hereby granted, with the following stipulations: the troopers' personnel files, (Jimmy Rogers, Derek Cormier, Zachery Matt and Paul Brady) which are to include, but not limited to reprimands and internal investigations, are be provided to the Court for an *in camera* inspection within ten (10) days of the hearing. Upon the Court's review, a decision will be given on what should be redacted and what should be given to the plaintiff's counsel.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Motion in Limine is granted, including the exclusion of any claims, lawsuits or introduction of the Social Security materials, unless this matter is revisited by the Court.
